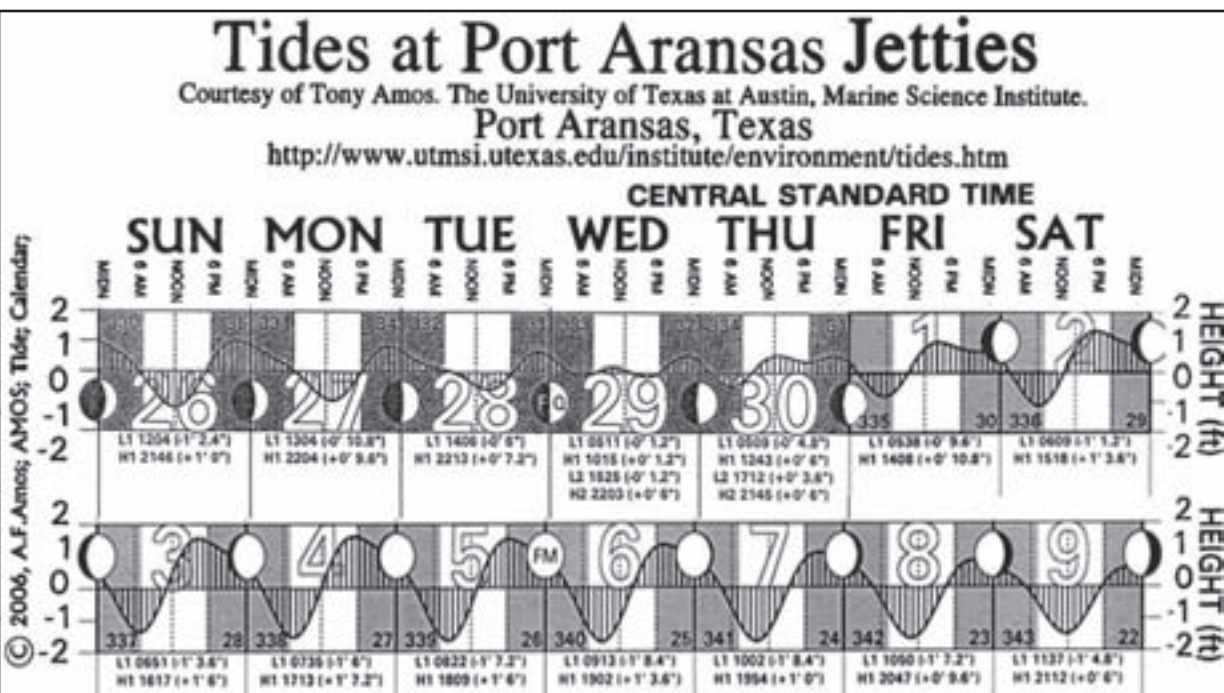

FISHING REPORT

Good catches precede upcoming cold front

Weather has been in the 80's this past week, but a cold front is predicted for the end of the week.

A 100-pound wahoo was the biggest catch this week out of **Dolphin Dock**. The longer trips are catching tuna, kings and dorado; with one 36-hour trip pulling in 300 blackfin and 25 yellowfin. The day-trippers are catching Atlantic sharpnose shark, amberjack, tuna, queen triggerfish, wahoo, ling, yellowfin and vermilion snapper, reported Bill Fintel.

A 500-pound mako shark was caught aboard the Gulf Eagle out of **Deep Sea Headquarters** this week. Capt. Keith Schoolcraft and first mate Tony Buzbee took anglers on the same trip to find lots of yellowfin

and blackfin tuna, a big grouper and dorado. Floater trips were productive with good catches of big game fish, said Rick Laros. Anglers on open boat every day 8-hour trips were catching limits of all the reef fish except red snapper. The 12-hour Wednesday trip were reeling vermilion snapper, shark, amberjack and kingfish. A lot of redfish and trout were caught in the bays.

Lots of pompano are being caught along with big croaker off Horace Caldwell Pier, said Sharon Keehlisen of **Woody's Sports Center**. Limits of speckled trout are being snagged off the jetties. Redfish are plentiful in the flats. Black drum are being caught near Ingleside. Flounder are being hooked near the Lydia Ann lighthouse shoreline. Whiting and sand trout are being pulled in of the piers. Offshore, it's snapper, shark, amberjack, yellowfin and blackfin tuna.

Vermilion, gray and lane snapper was caught on boats out of the **Offshore Adventures** along with Atlantic sharpnose shark, triggerfish, kingfish and tuna, reported Beverly Stapleton. Limits of redfish, trout, flounder and a few black drum made an appearance at the dock this week with anglers using mud minnows, live shrimp and mullet.

Atlantic sharpnose shark, king mackerel, barracuda, kingfish and blackfin tuna were the catches offshore on boats out of **Fisherman's Wharf** last week, said John McNatt. Anglers taking the Jetty Boat to the north jetty caught trout and redfish.
